Date	Area	Treatment Done:
Nov 2018	Building 1 – Acacia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Our inspection of the rodent boxes revealed that there is still activity at this building, currently it is still manageable. We did however find some activity of snails around the boxes. We will monitor this building closely in the next few months</li></ul>
	Building 2 – Baobab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The activity at Boabab increased slightly. We suspect this is due to the current weather conditions we are experiencing. All boxes had to be re-baited.</li></ul>
	Building 3 – Coral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All boxes were checked / In some areas we found a decrease in activity. Increased activity was found at the front stairs of the parking area</li></ul>
	Building 4 – Flamethorn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All boxes were checked / The front boxes had to be re-baited due to snail activity. This can cause an increase of rodent activity in this area, if a treatment for snails are not done.</li></ul>
	Building 5 – Dombeya	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The activity in this areas is at a manageable state, but we will still monitor this area closely.</li></ul>
	Building 6 – Gardenia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Rodent activity increased at this building at the middle parking area as well as the far end parking area. We have also noticed that you have a snail infestation at this building.</li></ul>
	Building 7 – Ebony	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>There was a noticeable increase in activity, but is still manageable at this stage.</li></ul>
	Refuse area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All boxes were checked and re-baited</li><li>This areas will always have activity due to the refuse bags being stored here until they are collected</li></ul>

Area	Findings
Refuse area	In general we found an increase of activity in this area due to the refuse bags not being taken away immediately. This area will always attract the rodents and other pests. This area will be monitored closely with each visit, as the rodents are attracted to the refuse.
Buildings 1 – 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In general there was a decrease in rodent activity in the complex. However, we did notice an infestation of snails in the complex, including the ants as reported previously.</li> <li>• The tenants / owners are welcome to contact us if they need us to come through and treat their units</li> </ul>
General findings	Just a reminder, with regards the rodent boxes that need to be re-installed and replaced, please can you advise the cleaning staff not to move or damage the boxes, as this will cause an increase of rodent activity.
