Date	Area	Treatment Done:
Dec 2018	Building 1 – Acacia	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked for activity / We have noticed that there is still activity at this building / We will monitor this building closely in the next few months
	Building 2 – Baobab	<ul style="list-style-type: none">There was a big increase in rodent activity detected. This is due to the snail infestation you have at this building. All boxes had to be re-baited
	Building 3 – Coral	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked / In some areas we found a decrease in activity. We did find increased activity in the far right corner of the building
	Building 4 – Flamethorn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked / We did notice a decrease in activity, in the middle of the building, but is still manageable at this stage.
	Building 5 – Dombeya	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked and some were re-baited / The activity in these areas decreased slightly to a manageable state, but we will still monitor this area closely.
	Building 6 – Gardenia	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked / Rodent activity increased at this building, as we had to rebait all the boxes. We have also noticed that you have a snail infestation at this building as well.
	Building 7 – Ebony	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked and half were re-baited / There was an increase in activity, but is still manageable at this stage.
	Refuse area	<ul style="list-style-type: none">All boxes were checked and re-baitedIncreased rodent activity detected in the main refuse area only due to the refuse bags not being taken away immediately

Area	Findings
Refuse area	In general we found an increase of activity in this area due to the refuse bags not being taken away immediately. This area will always attract the rodents and other pests. This area will be monitored closely with each visit, as the rodents are attracted to the refuse.
Buildings 1 – 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In general there was a decrease in rodent activity in the complex. However, we did notice a large infestation of snails at Boabab and Gardenia, including the ants as reported previously. • The tenants / owners are welcome to contact us if they need us to come through and treat their units
General findings	Just a reminder, with regards the rodent boxes that need to be re-installed and replaced, please can you advise the cleaning staff not to move or damage the boxes, as this will cause an increase of rodent activity.
